Who is eligible to apply?



Up to 5 honors high school students and 10 college and recent graduates (ages 16-25). Individuals with an interest in journalism, storytelling, LatinX community, arts and humanities, digital media, writing, research, oral history, cultural awareness, and self improvement.

What are the program dates and expected commitment from interns?

The Spring 2021 Semester starts on January 26 and ends on May 11th. Participants must commit to meet via Zoom every Tuesday from 5-7pm and dedicate about 90 additional minutes per week for at-home assignments.

Is this an unpaid internship?

S.P.E.L. is an unpaid internship program. However, participants who engage and complete the weekly assignments will receive a \$20/week stipend during the duration of the program.
